## Our Logo




## Logo Scale

Our logo is a key visual element that speaks to the rugged, natural landscape of Tofino while incorporating our relaxed, artistic character. Avoid scaling the logo so large that it becomes overpowering. Instead it should always be a subtle compliment to the stunning visuals and media it sits upon.



Conversely, we don't want our logo to be reduced to a size where it loses detail, legibility and presence. This is mainly an issue for digital placements. The recommended minimum width is 90px.



## Legibility & Contrast

It is essential that our logo stands out when placed over photography, video or colour. Use either the Pacific Blue or White versions to achieve a suitable level of contrast with the background. For greyscale reproduction, use the black or white version of the logo.
